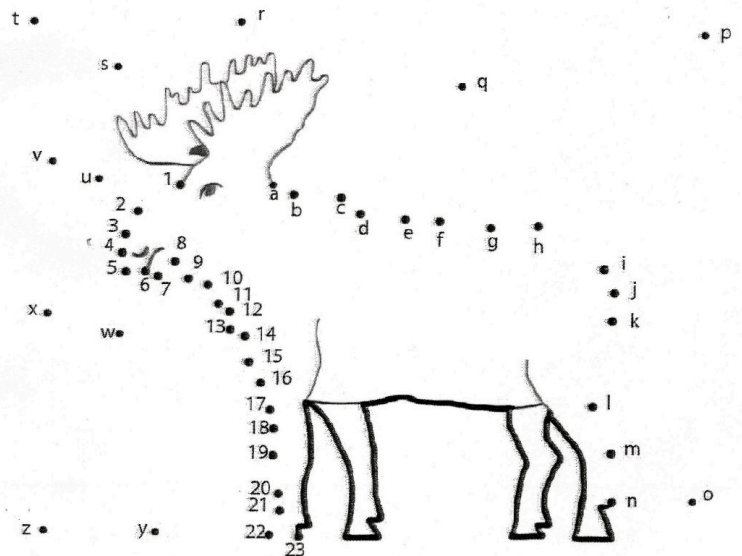

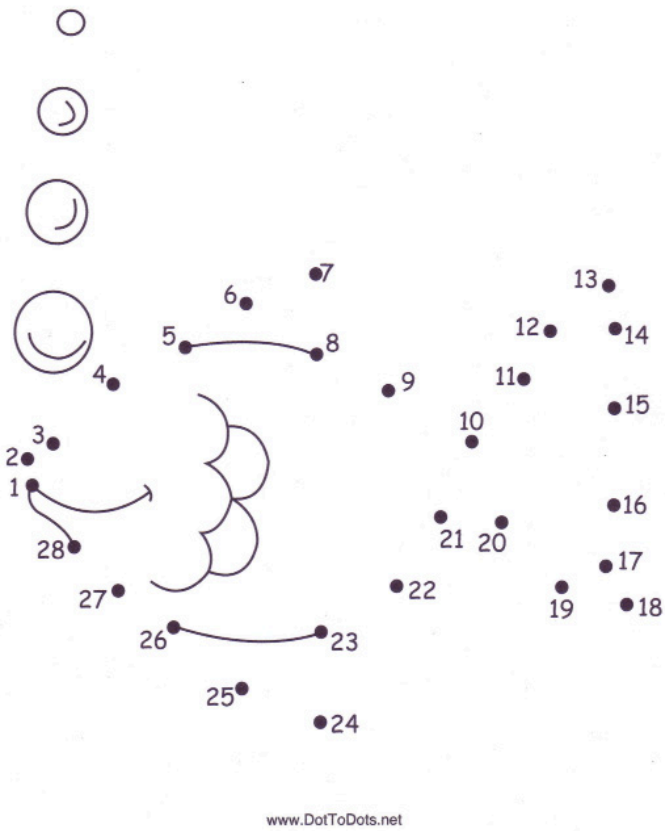
Moose Dot-to-Dot

ALASKA TRIVIA

We are the 49th State and we celebrated our 50th Anniversary of Statehood in 2009.

In 1867 United States Secretary of State William H. Seward offered Russia \$7,200,000, or two cents per acre, for Alaska.

The Trans-Alaska Pipeline moves up to 88,000 barrels of oil per hour on its 800 mile journey to Valdez.

The willow ptarmigan is the official state bird. The Territorial Legislature adopted it in 1955. The Sitka spruce is the official state tree. The Territorial Legislature adopted it in 1962.

An unnamed draftsman created the state seal in 1910. It consists of a rising sun shining on forests, lake, fishing and shipping boats, and agricultural and mining activities. The state motto is North to the Future.

The four-spot skimmer dragonfly is the official state insect.

17 of the 20 highest peaks in the United States are located in Alaska. At 20,320 feet above sea level, Denali, located in Alaska's interior, is the highest point in North America.

In 1915 the record high temperature in Alaska was 100 degrees Fahrenheit at Fort Yukon; the record low temperature was -80 degrees Fahrenheit at Prospect Creek Camp in 1971.
